CELEBRATING CONSERVATION EFFORTS: When it comes to protecting the environment, the Friends of Alum Creek and Tributaries (FACT) has been on the forefront of conservation efforts. *Resolution 0199X-2008*, sponsored by Recreation and Parks Committee Chair [Priscilla R. Tyson](#), recognizes the countless hours FACT members have volunteered to preserve Columbus' waterways. One of the group's most significant accomplishments was securing \$250,000 in grant funding for the lowhead dam removal/waterway corridor restoration project from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, which allowed the project to move forward without any cost to Columbus taxpayers.
