Two tree planting projects scheduled

The Friends of Alum Creek & Tributaries will conduct two tree planting service projects in April to help restore forested greenway that was removed when the Alum Creek paved trail was constructed.

The first planting will occur from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Saturday, April 12, near the I-70 underpass along the Alum Creek River and trail. Volunteers can access the work site via the Ohio Soil Recycling gate, 2101

Integrity Drive S. in Columbus.

The second planting will be 9 a.m. to noon Saturday, April 19, near the state Route 104 underpass. To access the work site, drive through the Refugee Road South trailhead gate, 2400 Alum Creek Drive.

Participants should wear work clothes and appropriate foot protection. Gloves, refreshments and snacks will be provided.
