The plant is located at 312 W. Main St., Westerville. According to FACT communications chair David Roseman, the purpose of the tour is to help visitors see how Alum Creek water is processed for public consumption.

Visitors will meet in the office at the plant's middle building; its entrance is at Collegeview, behind the COTA Park & Ride lot, north off of West Main Street.
